

Children's Music Program

A longstanding legacy of developing musical skills in children for the purpose of personal and corporate worship resides at FBC. The Children's Music Program focuses on music education, developing children as worship leaders, & spiritual growth through music. Children's choir & hand bells meet every Tuesday afternoon at 3:30 for all children (4K -6th grade). The church bus & van travel to Senatobia City Schools & to Magnolia Heights to pick up children @ 2:45. Upon arrival, they have free time & snacks. Then begins the fun! Our preschool choir (4K - kindergarten) meets in the preschool wing, our Music Makers (1st-3rd) meet in the old choir room upstairs, & our Young Musicians (4th-6th) meet in the choir room.



Special Events include Easter Egg hunts, Trick or Trunk, Fall Festival, scavenger hunts, trips to eat or laser tag, etc.



Upward Basketball & Cheerleading

Upward is open to all kids, K-5 through 6th grade. Upward equips kids with the athletic skills needed to participate at a higher level. Each player enjoys an exciting game time experience that improves skills and builds healthy self-confidence. It stresses values such as sportsmanship, teamwork, integrity and respect. Players receive special recognition at the end of the season, which goes from the middle of December through February or early March with registration having begun in late October and November.

Worship

Our church body gathers for worship every Sunday morning in the Sanctuary at 8:30 am and 11:00am. At a specified time in the service, our children (4 years through 4th grade) are dismissed with adult and youth leaders for Children's Church. While there, your kids will be encouraged to worship God through music, giving, and learning.

Sunday School

There is a Sunday school class for every age at FBC, including one for YOUR child. Sunday school is a time of learning from God's Word while developing relationships that are vital to the spiritual growth of our children.

Discipleship Training

At 5:00pm on Sunday evenings, our children gather for Discipleship Training. These age-appropriate groups will help your child in taking the next step in their spiritual development as they learn what it means to become increasingly like Jesus each day. We use Bible Drill, random acts of kindness, and topical curriculums to communicate the purpose of the Christian life to our kids. Join us immediately after for family worship in the sanctuary every Sunday evening at 6:00pm.



Mission Groups

Join us every Wednesday night at 6:15 p.m. as we teach our children how to carry the message of Christ around the world and to our community. These groups focus on missions education combined with hands-on ministry opportunities, teaching them to serve others with Godly love. Summer of Service (S.O.S.) kids (4th -6th) meet weekly to continue growing our hearts for service during June & July.



We began in 2014 a ministry just for our pre-teens helping them transition from the children's ministry into our youth program. Meets Wednesday nights at 6:15!
